The Endless Summer Car Camp Point Mugu State Park, La Jolla Canyon Campground Sept 12, 13, 14, 2003

COST: \$8.00 per person

TRIP LIMIT: 32 people

DESCRIPTION: This is as good as it gets! We will be camping at a private campground that is within 200 yards of the ocean. Point Mugu State Beach is located between Malibu and Oxnard, about a 75-minute drive from Pasadena.

The weather should be wonderful, warm days and warm nights. You can drive up on Friday (after work) or Saturday morning. You will have Saturday and Sunday to explore or just relax. There is hiking in the local canyons, a nearby sand dune (really a sandy hill), and the beach. If there is sufficient interest, bicycles can be dropped off at the Block's residence beforehand. On Saturday we can enjoy a downhill mountain bicycle ride (about 10 miles) to the beach down Sycamore Canyon to the ocean.

After breaking camp on Sunday, there should be time for some final activities before the drive home.

BRING: The normal car camping equipment -- tent, sleeping bag, stove, cooking utensils, food, and layered clothing. Bring a dish for a "Death Valley Happy Hour" on Saturday.

PRE-TRIP MEETING: Tuesday, September 9, 2003 in Conference Room 126-225 from 12 noon to 1:00 PM. Be there or be represented or make prior arrangements with the trip leader. Those who are not represented at the meeting could lose their reservations if the trip is over subscribed. Make your reservations (send in your check) early.
