James Dorsey is a writer/photographer who has traveled extensively in 31 countries. He has had feature articles in the Christian Science Monitor, Conde Nast Traveller UK, California Wild, Sea Kayaker and Wavelength magazines, plus both the China and Alaska Books of the TravelersTales series. He has appeared on National Public Radios' Weekend America program. When not on an expedition, he works as a Marine Naturalist for the American Cetacean Society and the Cabrillo Aquarium in San Pedro.

For this presentation James Dorsey will read from his collection of essays, "Tears, Fear, and Adventure", which surveys his decades of outdoor experiences. And what a selection of escapades to choose from: being charged by a 10-ton male killer whale while kayaking, nervously dodging landmines in the jungle, exploring painted caves in remote Baja, .... Come take an armchair adventure of your own listening to his tales and viewing his accompanying high definition digital images.
