KING HOLIDAY WEEKEND IN DEATH VALLEY JANUARY 18 to 21, 2008

CLASSIFICATION: Easy to Hard, your option **COST:** \$10.00 per person

TRIP LIMIT: 16 people maximum, limit of 4 cars, with overflow parking available

DESCRIPTION: Death Valley is located in the eastern California desert, about a 6 hour drive from Pasadena. This should be a great trip, the weather is **usually** nice this time of year, with sunny skies and cool evenings.

Terrain within the park range from below sea level at Badwater, to the top of Telescope Peak. Death Valley has plenty of activities (easy walks, tours of Scotty's Castle, and even a golf course), hiking in numerous canyons, and a range of 4-wheeling back road opportunities.

There is no set schedule for the trip, drive up on Friday (an RDO) or Saturday. You will have all day on Saturday and Sunday to explore, or revisit your favorite places. There will be a pot-luck happy hour on Saturday evening. After breaking camp on Monday (a JPL holiday), there should be time for some final activities before the drive home.

We will be staying at the Furnace Creek campground, which is within walking distance of the park's visitor's center, and about a mile from Furnace Creek Ranch.

BRING: The normal car camping equipment; tent, sleeping bag, stove, cooking gear, food, and layered clothing. Also, bring a share item for a pot-luck happy hour. This will be reviewed at the pre-trip meeting.

PRE-TRIP MEETING: On, Monday 14 January 2008 in Conference Room 301-474 from 12 noon to 1:00 PM. Be there, or be represented, or make prior arrangements with the trip leader. Those who are not represented at the meeting could lose their reservations if the trip is over subscribed. Reserve your space(s) early by **sending in your check** with the coupon below.
