DESCRIPTION: WHAT HAPPENED:

We continued maintenance on Colby Canyon Trail, with a long hike up from Angeles Crest to get to where the brushing and trail widening is needed in the middle, or driving up to Josephine Saddle and working down, depending upon road conditions, crew size and weather. The waterfall and streams are running good right now.

WHAT'S HAPPENING:

We will continue work on the Colby Canyon Trail, continuing with maintenance work - brushing and trail widening.

A separate flyer will be sent out about California Trails Day.

BRING: Dayhike gear (daypack, lunch, lots of water), sun screen, bug repellent, hat, sturdy shoes, and work gloves. You can bring your own tools or are welcome to use those from our group supply.

MEET- Meet in March at 8:15 AM at ball diamonds parking lot in the lower part of Hahamongna Park. Get off the 210 freeway at the Berkshire off-ramp and follow the signs for JPL and Hahamongna Park. Once you turn into the park, go down the driveway to the left, make a right at the bottom and look for us in the parking lot by the ball diamonds. (If that is full, we park in the dirt lot directly at the bottom of the driveway) We will sign in and form carpools, leaving at 8:30 sharp, returning around 4 PM. The leaders always take passengers, but make sure you have plenty of gas in case we need more drivers (riders can give drivers \$1 towards gas). If you need to leave early, notify the leaders at sign-in time.
