## DAWN MINE DAY HIKE

**Sunday, July 15, 2001**



**CLASSIFICATION:** Moderate

**DISTANCE:** 5 miles round trip **ELEVATION GAIN:** 1,200 feet

**DESCRIPTION:** We will walk up the Mt. Lowe Motorway to Dawn Station, then down the Dawn Mine Trail to Dawn Mine. The mine is adjacent to a stream - some boulder-hopping is necessary to get there.

**DIRECTIONS:** Go North on Lincoln Avenue in Altadena. Turn right at Loma Alta Drive. Then turn left onto Chaney Trail at the flashing yellow lights. Continue on Chaney Trail up the hill. Just after you go over the crest of the hill, there is a gate to the left and a small parking area before the gate. This is the entrance to the Mount Lowe Motorway. Park outside the gate. You must display a Forest Adventure Pass.

We will meet at the gate at 9:00 AM. There is no need to make a reservation. We will embark at 9:15 AM.

**BRING:** Comfortable shoes, at least a quart of fluid to drink, sun glasses, sunscreen, and lunch.
