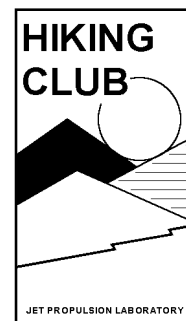

JUNE LAKE X/C SKI (YO-YO SKI OK)



SKI THE LAKES ...SKI A GLASS DOME...SKI THE MOUNTAIN

LEADER: Sheila Tews, 818-393-7947, M/S 230-305 **CLASSIFICATION:** Easy-difficult; up to you. **TRIP LIMIT:** 20.

COST: \$165/person (Club members and guests), \$170/person (non-members) private room, 2 to a room; \$130/person (Club members and guests), \$135/person (non-members) shared room or hide-a-bed. If we get enough people, the cost could go down. We will be staying at Interlaken on Silver Lake. It is very luxurious with all the facilities and a view. One condo has two king bedrooms, one bedroom with two double beds and a queen hide-a bed in the living room; the other has one bedroom with a king bed, one bedroom with a queen bed, one bedroom with three twin beds and a queen hide-a bed in the living room. The price includes 3 nights lodging, 3 breakfasts, 2 dinners, and a happy hour.

TRIP DESCRIPTION: We will drive up Thursday night after work. It's about 315 miles and 5-7 hours to get to the June Mountain ski area. Up for breakfast the next morning and those that want to do downhill with X-C or yo-yo ski equipment can head over to the June Mountain downhill area. Others can head for the Obsidian Dome area and ski the free tracks put in by the Forest Service or go off track and ski to the top of the Dome for lunch and a great view. Then continue up and down the hills around the dome or do some meadow track skiing. You can also head out to the June Lake Loop Road on your skis and enjoy the scenery you usually drive past at 40 mph. When you get back and finish your hot shower or bath you can help set up for happy hour and then help with the dinner preparation and clean up. We'll have a nice dinner prepared by the participants. You will be helping with the food buying, preparation and clean-up. Lunches are up to you. The next day (Saturday) head for the snow. Sunday morning get up; get breakfast; and, load up the vehicles. We then head out and ski the Dome area or try another place (up Bishop Creek Road or to Lake Sabrina). A lunch/dinner stop and we head home.

EQUIPMENT: Bring ski equipment, layered clothing, day or fanny pack, water bottle, snacks and lunches. We will provide more info at the coordination meeting. Drivers are required to have snow chains, winterized radiator, and should have a shovel.

PRE-TRIP MEETING: The pre-trip meeting will be held on Tuesday January 11, 2000 at noon in 301-227. Please be there or have someone represent you or you could be dropped from the trip. Priority is to Club members and their guests. In the event of an over or under subscription the club rules apply (i.e., a lottery for too many). If under subscribed by 1/11/00 all or part of the trip could be canceled (we lose \$'s on the condos). Also, after 1/11/00 your payment is non-refundable unless you find a replacement.
