Mt Lukens Expedition

Saturday, April 22, 2001

CLASSIFICATION: Moderate 13 miles round trip, 2000 feet elevation gain

DESCRIPTION: Mt. Lukens is the peak above La Crescenta with a lot of cellular antennas. It is 5045 feet high.

DIRECTIONS: Take Angeles Crest Highway North about 3 miles past the entrance sign to Angeles National Forest. Park in the turnoff area to the left: N 34 degrees 15.63', W 118 degrees 11.55'; C3 on Thomas Brothers Map 505.

We will meet at 9:00 AM. There is no need to make a reservation. The hike will start at 9:15 AM. We will walk on Grizzly Road to Mt. Lukens Road, then on to Mt. Lukens, where we will have lunch. We will return to the parking lot at around 3 PM.

The expedition will be cancelled in the event of rain.

BRING: Comfortable shoes, a half gallon of fluid to drink, sun glasses, sun screen, and lunch.
