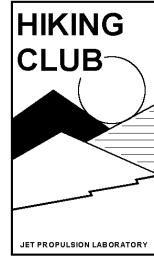

Mt. Wilson Day Hike via Old Mt. Wilson Trail Sunday, July 30

DIFFICULTY: Strenuous
LENGTH: 15 miles R/T
ELEVATION: 4,500 foot gain
MAPS: Mt. Wilson

Description: This is hike 40 in John Robinson's book "Trails of the Angeles. The hike starts up the Little Santa Anita Canyon and climbs up to meet the Winter Creek Trail near the head of the canyon. We cross this trail and continue on up to meet the Mt. Wilson Toll Road. From there we hike about 2 more miles to reach the Mt. Wilson Road at the top. We will relax and have lunch there before heading back down.

Bring: Daypack, sunscreen, bug repellent, 3 liters of water, lunch and snacks.
