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Antelope Valley California Poppy Reserve Stroll

Description: Wander through 1745 acres of the California state flower in bloom! According to the information line, the poppies should be at or near peak viewing for our visit. We'll start in the morning (details on mtg times below) and explore the seven miles of trails through the park. No dogs or mountain bikes are allowed on the trails (park rules). After lunch at the park, we will finish up exploring and head back in the early-to mid- afternoon.

Meet: At the entrance to the Poppy Reserve's Visitor Center at 0930.

Carpool option: Anyone interested in ridesharing should meet the trip leader in the JPL visitor's lot at 0730 to form the carpools. We will leave no later than 0745.

RSVP: None required.

Bring: Standard day hike gear-comfortable trail shoes, water, sunscreen, etc. Lunch to eat at the park picnic area. Camera and/or binoculars to capture/appreciate the views.

Cost: \$2/car to park (pay when you get there)

Directions: From Pasadena, take the 210 North to the 5 North to the 14 North. Follow the 14 to Lancaster. Head west on Avenue I/Lancaster Road about 15 miles to the Visitor's Center.
