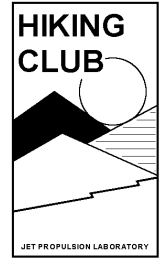

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San Gorgonio Backpack Trip via South Fork Trail

Friday August 18 to 20, 2000

TRIP LIMIT: 6 including leaders
DIFFICULTY: Moderate
LENGTH: 21 miles RT/6 miles to Base Camp (9,200')
STARTING ELEVATION: 6,900'
HIGH POINT: 11,499'
MAPS: Moonridge & San Gorgonio Mtn. 7.5' USGS Quads

DESCRIPTION: A trip to southern California's highest peak via its most accessible route. The trip starts at the Jenks Lake Rd. trailhead and heads up the San Gorgonio Wilderness' most heavily traveled trail to Lodgepole Springs/Dry Lake where we will set up a base camp for two nights.

This trip is well suited for backpackers of all skill levels.

GEAR & CLOTHING: You will need all backpacking essentials, such as, pack, tent, water purification, food, stove, fuel, clothing for temperatures as low as 20 F and a day pack/fanny pack for the peak ascent.

MEET: Friday 12:30 PM at Mill Creek Ranger Station which is at Bryant and Mill Creek Rd. (Rt.38).

DIRECTIONS: Take 210 south to 10 east in Pomona. Continue on 10 to the Alabama exit in Redlands and then head north to Lugonia (Rt. 38) where you Make a right turn heading east. You continue on Rt. 38 to Jenks Lake Rd., At about the 25.5 mile marker, and make a right. In about 3 miles there is a parking lot on the north side of the street marked for the South Fork Trail.
