DESCRIPTION:

We have 2 campsites at Wawona Campground in Yosemite National Park. Wawona is along Highway 41 approximately 26 miles from Yosemite Valley. It is along the Merced River and it is quieter and less congested than the valley. There are many beautiful hikes to take in Yosemite at all levels but what you do is up to you on this trip. You can choose to hike, relax at camp, tour the valley floor or go up to the high country. The waterfalls are usually pretty full at this time of the year with melting snows so hopefully they will be impressive. Plan to drive up on Thursday night. If you would like to leave on Friday, that would be alright as well. The drive is about 6-1/2 hours. The campgrounds have drinking water, sinks and flush toilets. All food must be stored in storage containers available at each campsite. No food can be stored in cars. There are general stores in the park at Curry Village in the valley, at Crane Flats and at Tuolumne Meadows. There are numerous places to eat in the valley and a restaurant at Wawona Lodge as well.

The usual carcamping equipment. Tent, stove, fuel, cooking stuff, chairs, sleeping bags, food, sunscreen, bug repellent, daypack, etc.
