Bailey Canyon Day Hike

Description:

This is a short, morning hike, starting at Bailey Canyon Park in Sierra Madre. This lovely wilderness area is owned by the city of Sierra Madre and the trail beautifully maintained by a group of volunteers whom we will probably encounter. The trail switchbacks up the south-facing side of the mountain, with continuous views of Arcadia, Sierra Madre, and the picturesque old Passionis Fathers' monastery. We will plan to stop for a brief rest at the old cabin ruins, 2.2 miles and 1000 feet above our starting point, then turn around and come back down. The round trip should take about 2 hours. If you're interested, we can lunch together at Corfu, a cozy Greek café in Sierra Madre.

Bring: Water, sunscreen, hat, etc.

Meet:

At 9:30 AM in the parking lot of Bailey Canyon Park. From the 210, exit at Baldwin, and go north toward Sierra Madre. About 1/2 mile above Sierra Madre Blvd., take a left (west) on Grandview. Go about 3/4 mile (more or less to Grove (one street past Lima, which has a stop sign) and turn right (north). Grove dead ends at Bailey Canyon Park a couple of blocks up. (Grandview goes through to Michillinda, so, alternatively, you can take the Michillinda exit from the 210, north to Grandview, east to Grove, north to Bailey Canyon Park
