Turn left (north) onto Angeles Forest Hwy, go 1 mile to Pines Parking Area, turn left into parking lot. Allow 1/2-Hour Driving Time from the 210 Fwy. Carpool if possible. For those who wish to carpool with JPL Trailbuilders, we will meet at Oak Grove Ranger Station at 7:30 am and return after the lunch.

The USDA Forest Service and associated LARRD volunteer organizations will celebrate California Trails Day on April 20, 2002. The celebration will include 4-6 hours of trail work on the Pines Picnic Area trails system, and a barbecue lunch at the Pines Picnic Area.
