## AFTER WORK EATON CANYON HIKE / POT LUCK

**Rating: Easy to Moderate Distance: About 3 1/2 miles round trip**

**Description:** We will walk from Ed's house for about a mile through Altadena to the beginning of the trail to Henninger Flats. We'll cross the bridge, then descend down to the stream. We will hike along the stream about 3/4 mile to the falls. The walk involves some rocky terrain, and we must cross the stream several times by stepping from rock to rock. (Ed did the hike yesterday and saw several 7 or 8 year old kids manage the stream crossing quite nicely.) Also, there is a little poison oak to watch out for. But the hike is lovely - quite wooded - and the falls are spectacular! We will return by the same route to Ed's house, planning to be back by 7 p.m.

Anyone who wants to is welcome to stay at at Ed's house for a pot luck. If you plan to stay, please bring some food to share - any food you'd like, enough to feed yourself (yourselves). You are welcome to use Ed's stove and/or refrigerator. NOTE: Ed does NOT have a microwave; can someone bring one?

**What to bring:** Water, comfortable shoes/hiking boots, food for the pot luck

**Directions:** From the 210 freeway heading West, take the Allen Ave. offramp. Heading East, take the Hill Ave. offramp and continue East on the street paralleling the freeway about 1/2 mile to Allen Ave.

Take Allen Ave. North about 2 1/2 miles to Midwick Dr. The last signal light you will pass is New York Drive. If you reach the stop sign at Allen and Mendocino, you've gone one block too far. Turn left from Allen onto Midwick. The street forks immediately; take the right-hand fork. Ed lives at 1746 Midwick Dr (south side of the street).

**Meet at 4:45 p.m.** Ed Rinderle's house. Please be prompt; we will leave promptly at 5:00!
