DOWNTOWN LA WALK

CLASSIFICATION: Easy

COST: approx. \$14

TRIP LIMIT: 30

DESCRIPTION:

Gather at Union station. Hike across the street to El Pueblo Plaza, on to Spring Street, walk by City Hall and down to the Old Bank District. Proceed over to Broadway, go in the Bradbury Building, and then stop at Grand Central Market for lunch (about \$5).

Climb 155 steps up Bunker Hill. Proceed on to the Water Court of California Plaza, MOCA, Disney Concert Hall, Wells Fargo Court, Bunker Hill Steps, into Central Library, Maguire Gardens, Biltmore Hotel, Pershing Square, then take the Red Line subway (90 cents) back to Union Station.

Total miles: 2 – 3.

MEET:

Meet at 10 a.m. at Union Station, just north of the 101 freeway on Alameda and east of the infamous Four Level. It looks like a big Spanish-style church. Watch for signs as you get close. The parking lots are in front; enter from Alameda. Parking at Union Station is about \$8, but the lot in front of Terminal Annex is cheaper (NE corner of Alameda and Cesar Chavez—north across the street from Union Station).
