Saturday, June 2, 2001

TIME: 8:30 a.m.

LOCATION: Meet at Short Cut Fire Station Entrance, off of Big Tujunga Canyon Road

DIRECTIONS:

From 210 Fwy, go north on Angeles Crest Hwy past Red Box station to Big Tujunga Canyon Road. Turn left (north) onto Big Tujunga Canyon Road, go 1.1 miles and you will see the entrance to the Short Cut Fire Station on the left. After a 180-degree turn, park off the road on the west side of the road. Additional parking is available in a small area south of the entrance. Allow 1 1/2-Hour Driving Time from the 210 Fwy. Carpool if possible.

DESCRIPTION:

The USDA Forest Service and associated LARRD volunteer organizations will celebrate National Trails Day on June 2, 2001 with California Trails Days Rescheduled. The celebration will include 4-6 hours of trail work on the Silver Moccasin Trail, and a barbecue lunch at Charlton Picnic Area. This event is sponsored by the volunteer groups of the Los Angeles River Ranger District. Lunch will be held at Charlton Picnic Area and will include a short ceremony. Lunch will be served at 1:30 P.M.

This activity is open to all volunteers, including sponsored groups. Those who are volunteering for trail work for the first time, please identify yourself to the registrar, so we can arrange for a Trail Boss to provide instruction and proper tools. Please bring personal equipment listed below.
