## DEVILS PUNCHBOWL DAY HIKE

**DESCRIPTION:** Devils Punchbowl County Natural Area is a 1,310-acre Los Angeles County park with more than five miles of hiking trails through towering rock formations. It is one mile away from the San Andreas fault. Park elevation starts at 4,200 feet and climbs to 6,500 feet above sea level. A small nature center features live animals, plants and natural history exhibits.

We will take a wooded, one-mile loop trail to the 350-foot-deep Devil's Punchbowl, created by seismic pressure on rock beds.

**BRING:** Food, something to drink, sun screen, daypack, appropriate clothes (check weather before leaving)

**MEET:** Devils Punchbowl is 52 miles from JPL. We will meet there at 10:00 a.m. Contact the trip leader if you need a map or are interested in car pooling.
