DESCRIPTION:

1st hike in the morning: Meet at Diamond Valley Lake Visitor Center at 9:30 A.M.

Directions to Diamond Valley Lake: East on 60, take I215 South, East on Hwy 74, Florida Ave, South on State St., West (turn right) on Newport Road to Diamond Valley Lake Visitor Center.

2nd hike in the afternoon: Meet at orange railway Museum main visitor entrance at 1:00 P.M. and/or adjacent picnic area.

Directions from Diamond Valley Lake viewpoint: North on Hwy 79 (Winchester Rd) to Hwy 74, go West on 74 to Perris, crossing over the I-215, go through Perris, past depot and turn left (South) on "A" Street. Continue South to museum (Perris Airport is about 1 mile east of the museum).

BRING: Money, hat and sun protection, water, walking shoes, lunch/snacks, kids and family and friends. Perris has many restaurants and fast food vendors.
