## **MEET:**

### **Note meeting place change**

For March 15, meet at 8:15 AM at ball diamonds parking lot in the lower part of Hahamonga Park. (Oak Grove Ranger station is now fenced off). Get off the 210 freeway at the Berkshire off-ramp and follow the signs for JPL and Hahamonga Park. Once you turn into the park, go down the driveway, make a right at the bottom and look for us in the parking lot by the ball diamonds. . We will sign in and form carpools, leaving at 8:30 sharp, returning around 4 PM. The leaders always take passengers, but make sure you have plenty of gas in case we need more drivers (riders can give drivers \$1 towards gas). If you need to leave early, notify the leaders at sign-in time. Flyer will follow about meeting and carpooling for April 12.
